



NARROW-LEAVED BUR-REED

Sparganium angustifolium

Habitat Preference

Found in freshwater ponds and lakes, as well as slow-moving rivers and streams.

Characteristics W



Vegetative

Linear, basal (2) leaf blades, one per node (12), along the stem.

Flowers

Round flower heads with spike-like arrangements, green to brown/white. Burr-like seed embedded inside the flowers.

Ecological Contributions to Lake Champlain

- Fruits are a source of food for waterfowl.
- Prefer oligotrophic (13) waters and can be an indicator of these conditions.
- Provide cover for larvae of fish such as northern pike.
